Emanuela Orlandi Moved to London: "She May Have Been in the Vatican Residence in Wimbledon"

Emanuela Orlandi moved to London may not have lived with the Scalabrinian Fathers. "The Vatican residence is in Wimbledon, in front of a private hospital."

From criminality to the far right, from the hypothesis that Emanuela was pregnant to the correspondence between the Archbishop of Canterbury and Cardinal Poletti to the yellow-red necklace as proof of the passage of the fifteen-year-old and the email sent by the alleged jailer . While Pietro Orlandi continues to say he is still convinced of the hypothesis that his sister was transferred to London, the English lead continues to find confirmation and to admit new hypotheses. After the confirmations on the secret service flight requested by the Vatican, a former agent of the English secret services has suggested doing further investigations on the alleged place where Emanuela Orlandi was staying.

"The one in Clapham Road is not the only Scalabrinian Fathers' hostel in London," he said. "In addition, in Wimbledon there is a Vatican residence with a private hospital nearby ."

Emanuela Orlandi and the Wimbledon hypothesis: "There is a private hospital nearby" While in Italy there are those who openly and unconditionally side with the Vatican, such as Francesca Immacolata Chaouqui, according to whom, if the Pope did not report what he knows he would be guilty of complicity in the crime of concealing a corpse, in Great Britain there are those who, with an English accent but clearly of Italian origin, are trying to collaborate.

" I worked for years in the intelligence of the London police , now I deal with health - the source who spoke was anonymous who got in touch with the journalist of Far West, the program hosted on Rai Tre by Salvo Sottiele - In London there are two hostels of the Scalabrinian fathers, not just the one in Clapham Road (to which they would take the five sheets with the expense reports of Emanuela Orlandi's stay in London, ed.). Furthermore, in Wimbledon there is a Vatican residence that is located near a private hospital. An abortion could have been performed there".

The hypothesis that Emanuela Orlandi arrived in London pregnant , in fact, is not excluded even by the Marshal of the Air Force who confirmed the secret service flight requested by the Vatican . The one who requested them was Cardinal Piovanelli. "But I didn't tell him," the former soldier said during the interview.

"It is still of vital importance that Miss Emanuela Orlandi remains alive and healthy, even a fetus in the womb is endowed with life", we would also read in the correspondence between Cardinal

Poletti and the Archbishop of Canterbury . A correspondence that, like many documents that emerged after the 2000s, is recognized as a forgery by the Vatican.

The Archbishop of Canterbury, the nuns: no one has ever heard of Emanuela Orlandi
Arriving in London to try to reconstruct the stages of the English trail, each character who appears (or, at least, those they manage to meet) says they have never heard of Emanuela Orlandi, of her disappearance, of Cardinal Poletti whose signature, as anticipated, is reported in the documents that emerged in 2017, although they have never been recognized by the Church.

The priest who was in charge of the hostel at the time only responded after a long and embarrassing silence. He reacted to the possibility of having seen something or met Emanuela Orlandi in the residence of the Scalabrinian Fathers: "Frankly, I have never been interested in the subject. Even among ourselves we laugh about it: how is it possible that they think she was here?" The nuns who take care of the residence where Camillo Cimin was apparently a guest during his trips to London to check on Emanuela , according to some testimonies and reconstructions, admit to having heard about the fifteen-year-old: "We don't know him. But do you really think they would have sent her here, among other Italian students? We have no idea whether she came or not, it's a mystery ."

Finally, the Archbishop of Canterbury is also reached, whose signature is reported in the correspondence (or presumed to be such) with Cardinal Poletti. "As an archbishop I have never met him", he says, without specifying whether or not I have seen him before or after his mandate. Then he quickly straightens his aim, looking at the printed document: "I believe it is a document. And yes, it could be my signature - he says - But for me it is a fake. I do not know why our names appear. I am retired now. I do not know anything about this person, I do not know at all what it is about. If he was a cardinal, if he was corrupt, if he laundered money. I do not know him. Why would he have contacted me? I have no idea".

The Vatican and Emanuela Orlandi: "First the investigations, now they'll even start asking for flights"

After the revelations of a defense ministry official, who during the Far West program hosted by Salvo Sottile on Rai Tre was revealed to be the Air Force Marshal Giuseppe Di Uguardi, the hypothesis of the flight requested by the Vatican to the Italian secret services seems to receive further confirmation. It would be a request and, consequently, an unusual treatment for the secret services. "In my memory, it has never happened: it was an atypical and anonymous case - he says - From Emanuela Orlandi, at the end of that summer of 1983, every now and then I heard some gossip: The investigations we have to do are not enough, now they'll start asking for the flights too , some said".

The former marshal, moreover, would also be willing to speak directly with the Holy See: "I personally called the Vatican's office of the promoter of justice three times in ten days, but each time they had no interest in listening to me. Honestly, I saw a closure of the Vatican - he continues - In their minds, rather than investigate, they choose to let time pass. Sooner or later

people will die. And these things will no longer be spoken of. And yet, even the most unspeakable secrets are all confessable ".
